COVID-19 Updates

Contra Costa County Health Department has set the county's reopening level back to purple, the most restrictive tier.

As a result of this directive, the following policy changes are being implemented in the parish:

- All indoor in-person liturgies have been suspended.
- Outdoor liturgies are still allowed under the directive but due to the cold weather, St. Ignatius of Antioch is not anticipating scheduling any outdoor liturgies at this time.
- **Sunday Liturgy will continue to be uploaded to YouTube every Sunday morning. Visit the parish website for links: stignatiusofantioch.org**
- **Sunday walk-up Holy Communion will continue from 10:30 am to 11:30 am each Sunday.**
- The parish office is closed. Office staff availability is limited but voicemail and email will be checked frequently.
- All non-essential gatherings remain suspended. Any essential business meetings must be held virtually or outdoors.
