Walk-up Holy Communion: Sunday 10:30 - 11:30 am.



COVID-19 Updates

Contra Costa County has made it to the red tier! This means that the virus is slowing down somewhat in the county, and that indoor liturgies may once again take place.

- The indoor in-person liturgies will take place this weekend, March 20th at 4:00 pm and March 21st at 9:00 am. Please be sure to arrive at least 10 minutes early for each of these liturgies.
- A Flocknote email for reservations of upcoming liturgies will be sent the week that the liturgy takes place. We are limited to the number of people per liturgy and a waiting list will be taken, if needed. **Watch for updates via Flocknote or the parish website.**
- **Sunday Liturgy continues to be uploaded to YouTube every Sunday morning.**
- **Sunday walk-up Holy Communion continues from 10:30 am to 11:30 am each Sunday.**
- The parish office is closed. Office staff availability is limited but voicemail and email are checked frequently.
- All non-essential gatherings remain suspended. Any essential business meetings must be held virtually or outdoors.

Palm Sunday & Holy Week Schedule

Palm Sunday - Saturday, March 27th, 4:00 p.m., Vigil Liturgy in Church; Reservations by Flocknote with only 90 people; temperatures will be taken, masks required, and social distancing.

Sunday, March 28th, 9:00 a.m., Liturgy in the Church; Reservations by Flocknote with only 90 people; same guidelines as mentioned previously. Walk Up Communion at 10:30 – 11:30 a.m.

We will begin the Sacred Paschal Triduum with the Celebration of Holy Eucharist on Holy Thursday, April 1st, at 3:00 p.m. The Liturgy will be celebrated in the church with a maximum of 90 parishioners. Same guidelines as mentioned previously.

April 2nd, 12:00 Noon, Stations of the Cross in the Parking Lot; no reservations, however, masks are required along with social distancing—led by our Knights of Columbus and Steve Rojek. 3:00 p.m. The Solemn Commemoration of The Lord's Passion and Death; in church with a maximum of 90 persons; reservations required via Flocknote. Because of the pandemic, we will not be able to approach the Cross for veneration (touching, kissing, embracing, passing).

Saturday, April 3rd, Holy Saturday Evening, 8:00 p.m., Easter Liturgy in Church with a maximum of 90 persons, reservations via Flocknote.

Sunday, April 4th, Easter Day, 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. in Church with a maximum of 90 persons; reservations required through Flocknote; **12:30 – 1:30 p.m.** Walk Up Communion.
