COVID-19 Updates

Contra Costa County has made it to the red tier! This means that the virus is slowing down somewhat in the county, and that indoor liturgies may once again take place.

- We are planning to return to indoor in-person liturgies at 4:00 pm on Saturday and at 8:00 and 10:00 am on Sunday after Easter. Please be sure to arrive at least 10 minutes early for each of these liturgies. (*See below for Easter Schedule.*)
- A Flocknote email for reservations of upcoming liturgies will be sent the week that the liturgy takes place. We are limited to the number of people per liturgy and a waiting list will be taken, if needed. **Watch for updates via Flocknote or the parish website.**
- **Sunday Liturgy continues to be uploaded to YouTube every Sunday morning.**
- **Sunday walk-up Holy Communion continues from 10:30 am to 11:30 am each Sunday.**
- The parish office is closed. Office staff availability is limited but voicemail and email are checked frequently.
- All non-essential gatherings remain suspended. Any essential business meetings must be held virtually or outdoors.
