Their careful preparation and delivery of the
Scripture verses enhance the service for
those in attendance.

What is required to be a Lector?

If you are Fully Initiated in the Faith, that is, Baptized, Confirmed, and have received First Eucharist, and are registered in the Parish, you may become a Lector. You will be trained in the procedures that are used during the Liturgies here at St. Ignatius of Antioch.

When your training is completed you will be Commissioned at Mass in front of the Assembly. After that, you will be assigned To Lector with a partner. There is ongoing training and Evenings of Reflection.
